

**LOCATION:**

Dungeness, Washington

**DATE:**

Sunday, March 22nd 2009.

**RACE TIMES:**

**COURSE:**

Very flat chip-seal surfaced course (2-3 rollers) but wind frequently has been a factor usually out of the west between 10 to 20 mph. Course is the same as in years past. Finish will likely be on Kitchen Dick Rd. before the corner for safety reasons. Each lap is 12 miles long.

**PRIZES:**

\$1000 worth of cash and merchandise prizes. Each race will have prizes allocated 3 deep. Tour de Dung 1 & 2 will be awarded as separate races.

**REGISTRATION:** (Race Day Only)

Parking and porta-lets will be located in the field across the road from the Dungeness State Park and Recreation Area. Registration opens at 8:00 AM and closes 15 minutes prior to the start of your race.

**COST:**

\$25 for all USA cycling licensed categories. One-day USA cycling licenses available for \$10 (Men Cat 5 and Women Cat 4 only). No race day licenses except for Cat 5 men and Cat 4 women, no one-year USA cycling licenses on sale at the event. USA Cycling provided insurance surcharge of \$3 per rider per day.

**WSBA NUMBERS:**

WSBA numbers will be used and can be purchased at [www.wsbaracing.com](http://www.wsbaracing.com). Rental numbers will be available at the race for \$10 rental fee (of which \$5 is refundable). For out-of-state riders there is no fee to rent a number just a \$5 deposit. Number must be worn on the left side of jersey and frame.

**WATER:**

No water at start, so bring your own water.

**WHEEL SUPPORT:**

Wheels in/wheels out. Possibly neutral wheel support.

**DIRECTIONS:**

*From Seattle:* using the Bainbridge Island Ferry: Exit the ferry at Winslow. Stay on SR 305 to Poulsbo. Proceed through Poulsbo and take SR 3 north (follow signs to the Hood Canal Bridge). Follow directions from Canal Bridge. From the Edmunds-Kingston Ferry: Remain on SR 104 the Canal Bridge. Follow directions from Canal Bridge.

*From Tacoma:* Take SR 16 from the Tacoma Narrows Bridge north. At the junction with SR 3, take SR 3 north to the Hood Canal Bridge. At the Canal Bridge, make a left turn (right turn if you are coming from Kingston) and proceed across the bridge (on SR 104). Follow SR 104 to the junction with US Hwy 101. Take US 101 North toward Pt. Townsend and Pt. Angeles. Follow US 101 past Sequim, stay on Highway 101 until you reach Kitchen Dick Road, take a right onto Kitchen Dick Road. Continue on Kitchen Dick Road, past Woodcock when you will be on the race course, all the way to Lotzgesell Road Rd where the parking area and Start/Finish location.

*From Olympia and South:* Take US Hwy 101 north. Follow US 101 past Sequim, stay on Highway 101 until you reach Kitchen Dick Road, take a right onto Kitchen Dick Road. Continue on Kitchen Dick Road, past Woodcock when you will be on the race course, all the way to Lotzgesell Road Rd where the parking area and Start/Finish location.

## COURSE PROFILE

12 mile circuit

1. Head east on Lotzgesell Rd
2. Turn left at Cays Rd/Old Town Rd
4. Turn right at E Anderson Rd
6. Slight right at Sequim Dungeness Way
7. Head south on Sequim Dungeness Way toward Woodcock Rd
8. Turn right at Gaskell Rd/Woodcock Rd
9. Head west on Woodcock Rd toward Kitchen Dick Rd/Kitchen-Dick Ln
10. Turn right at Kitchen Dick Rd/Kitchen-Dick Ln
